

CMP Monthly Report August 11, 2017

Overview:

This report will contain the activities from mid-May to mid-August.

Latest workings:

RID Approved Sponsors are now being required to submit audit materials for one activity type. In fall of 2015, the activity type being audited was Academic Coursework. SCRID did not process any AC for that time, thus, CMP was not audited. The spring of 2016, the activity type being audited was PINRAs. Though SCRID did process quite a few, RID PDC did not request an audit from CMP.

Received word from RID PDC that the next cycle of audits will commence in August 2017 and the activity type will be IS. Currently, CMP has not processed any IS.

Received an email from a participant, where two workshop CEUs were not appearing on the participant's transcript. The report generated from the uploading of the CEUs showed the participant was entered. RID CMP informed us that the participant didn't renew the associate membership. When membership dues lapse, any CEUs earned will not appear on the transcript and cannot be added when membership dues are paid.

Been in contact with a possible host to process their workshop CEUs, a group called Mentoring and Interpreting Agency, Inc (MAIA).

Working with LinguistPD to approve their archived webinars for CEUs.

Motion passed for implementing the Complimentary Benefit (a.k.a. "Benefit") for the certified and associate members. The information was uploaded onto the webpage under the tab Earn CEUs – Complimentary Benefit CEUs for Members Only – on 6/25/2017. Updated the Complimentary Benefit CEU event in WA. It has been activated on July 1st at 6 am. Sent out an email and posted it on Facebook. For the Month of July, we have had 3 requests for the Complimentary Benefit but only one officially has been used.

Attended RID meeting on July 2nd. The discussion of PPO CEUs were discussed. We are to earn 1.0 CEU for PPO. How will that be evaluated by CMP Sponsors? How will that look with the membership requirements on the transcript (under PS or GS totals) or something else? Asked Mish Ktejik and Erica West Oyedele, where are the motions kept on the RID website to review. It passed at the biennial conference of RID in 2015. These type of CEUs have not been implemented. RID is still working on the procedures to implement the logistically point of view. Anna Witter-Merithew mentioned this will be a focus of HQ following the national conference.

Contacted Richard Laurion and other CMP Sponsors on how do I exactly approve Legal CEUs for SC:Ls. There is no procedure or actual guidelines.

In contact with RID PDC to learn what is involved in processing conference CEUs for Region 5. Have not yet made the decision to do it or not.

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SCRID President asked that the Click Here to Submit the Complimentary Benefit link to WA be made either larger or in a different color. The font color was changed to RED. There are two places within the webpage to submit the request. One before the FAQ and one at the end of the page.
