Vice President's Annual Report 2017-2018

SCRID Leadership:

- Attended all monthly online board meetings (Aug. 11, 2017; Oct. 13, 2017; Feb. 9, 2018; Mar. 9, 2018; May 11, 2018); and all face-to-face meetings (Sept. 23, 2017; Nov. 18, 2017; Apr. 28, 2018; and today, June 23, 2018).
- Participated in Audit and Interpreting protocol meetings, July 29, 2017.
- Communicated with/responded to all board member and committee requests
 - Information sharing, meeting minutes reviews, etc.
- Met with treasurer to assist in PayPal access issues and helped secure the approval for the PayPal card swiper, which was delivered to SCRID by mail, and provided to the PDC. Offered to assist treasurer in email consolidation, filing (on-going).
- Ongoing development of procedures to recruit interpreters for our needs during online &/or face-to-face meetings. Our face-to-face meetings were covered by volunteers, who received vouchers for free future SCRID workshops: Oct. 13, 2017, K. Goodson, Nov. 18, 2017, J. Krause & C. Allard, and April 28, 2018, P. Morales.
 - Discussion of the need to budget for paid interpreters for face-to-face meetings is needed. SCRID needs to model the value held for the work done by interpreters.
 - It is clear that the offer of a free SCRID workshop voucher is insufficient to draw qualified volunteers to the task of interpreting for our meetings, and is unsatisfactory in representing the value that interpreting work should receive
- Ongoing development of procedures to recruit IEP/ITP internship/practicum opportunities at our face-to-face meetings.
 - CSUN's Deaf Studies, VIP Intern Interpreting Coordinators have made contact and are interested in working with SCRID.
 - Other contacts include: El Camino College, Bob LoParo; Jaclyn Krause & Tom Moran, Bakersfield College; Jeff Pollock & Cass Kroener, CSUN; and Diana MacDougall, Riverside College.
 - I will continue to pursue other IEP/ITP contacts as well, such as Mt. SAC.

- I will promote further discussion about the possibility of offering a more structured mentoring process to any students who wish to practice at our face-to-face meetings

SCRID 50th Anniversary Jubilee Committee:

- Worked a great deal with the SCRID 50th Anniversary Jubilee Committee.
 - Collected/borrowed SCRID related material from NCOD Pepnet Resource Center (NCOD Library) with assistance from Tony Ivankovic, and the SCRID storage facility (albums, notebooks, newsletters, flyers, etc.) with Caroline Preston Bass, Joyce Linden, and Patty Drasin
 - Received photo albums of SCRID and NCOD events over the years from Linnie Stone's personal collection, which were used in the development of the slideshow for the Jubilee. All albums were returned to Linnie after the Jubilee.
 - Developed and sent sponsorship and donation letters
 - Made contact with several former SCRID Presidents regarding their attendance at the Jubilee
 - Collected numerous letters from former presidents to be included in the slideshow/USB gift
 - Solicited the Jubilee flyer design/logo from Deaf artist, Stephanie Zornova
 - Created the Jubilee slideshow (the history of SCRID: 1967-2017) which was uploaded onto USBs as a gift for the Jubilee participants; had the Jubilee design printed onto the USBs
 - Secured a table for 10 at the Jubilee
 - A Thank You card was sent to Jim D'Addario for his work at creating a movie version with music of the slideshow
 - Attended and supported the Jubilee by working the registration desk and by interpreting with assistance from Patty Drasin and Caroline Preston Bass
- Served as acting secretary for board meetings: Sept. 23, 2017-Nov. 18, 2017, while we were without an official secretary.
- Served as Ad Hoc Election Committee Chair for the Special Election.
