

CMP Monthly Report October 13, 2017

Overview:

This report will contain the activities from mid-September to mid-October.

Latest workings:

Updated the CMP Sponsor volunteer description position.

Sent in letter of resignation to the SCRID Board and Committee Chairs. Last day is November 30, 2017.

The closer to November 30th, the chances are I will be even more busy getting ready for the move.

Only one person expressed an interest in being the CMP Sponsor. We talked about the position. Encouraged he contact the President. Have not heard anything more since. Sent a text message asking if he contacted the President or if he needed anything from me. Have not heard back.

Sent an email reminder to the four members who have IS, that their ISs are not due until 2018. So, they would not have to rush to complete them before I leave.

Worked with the LA Superior Court on their CIMCE courses so the Sign Language Interpreter employees could get CEUs for them. Recently heard from another training person. Explained how the set up was designed and why.

One participant from the September 23rd workshop (after the Face-to-Face meeting) received an error in uploading to the RID DB. Put the person in contact with RID. Found out that the spelling of their last name was entered incorrectly.

Shalene Germani who is a PDC member of the RID PDC Committee sent out an email discussing the recent CMP audit with four items of concern. Other members on this Committee are: Richard Laurion (Chair), Mary Darragh MacLean, Dawn Duran, and Lisa Weems.

Keep in mind, SCRID was **not** audited.

First item of discussion was dealing with the promotional materials especially with the non-discrimination statement. Three examples were sent to me. I reviewed SCRID PDC non-discrimination statement. Question is, would SCRID PDC want to change the statement or leave as is?

SCRID:

Non-Discrimination: Presenter and participants agree to foster an environment of mutual respect free from bias of any kind.

Examples provided by the RID PDC committee:

IS – Independent Study AC – Academic Coursework WS – Workshop
PINRA – Participant Initiated Non-RID Activity

ACET – Associate Continuing Education Tracking

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Minimal:

[Company/Agency] promotes an environment of mutual respect free of discrimination based on gender, sexual orientation, race, religion, or any other protected class.

A little more detail:

[Company/Agency] fosters an environment of mutual respect and inclusion that is free from harassment, bias and discrimination based on race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression, age, national origin (ancestry), disability, marital status, sexual orientation, or military status,

More detail:

[Company/Agency] is providing this workshop as an opportunity for safe, respectful learning and will not permit harassment, discrimination or horizontal violence based on another's comments, questions, schema, race, color, religion, gender, gender expression, age, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation or any other protected class.

SCRID PDC now has a standard template for promotional materials (i.e., the flyer) where the elements that RID PDC require are present.

Second item of discussion was the weak educational objectives (EO). The SCRID PDC Committee knows how firm I am with the EOs being written using measurable verbs. It seems that other Sponsors are not as firm and have been using thinking verbs (e.g., learn, understand). Thinking verbs can be used, however, they must be quantified.

Third item of discussion was the justification statement. This is when the workshop or topic could swing either way – PS or GS. The CMP Sponsors send out a request for the host/presenter or interpreter to justify why the Sponsor should approve the activity as PS. SCRID did have one presenter wanting Legal PS CEUs to be given, a request for justification was sent out. However, s/he did not reply to the justification request and the workshop was give PS CEUs.

The last item of discussion was missing audit submission materials. Forms were sent requesting information and some Sponsors did not send in all that was asked for.

I want to thank the SCRID PDC Committee for putting up with my demands on the RID Instructor form and promotional materials. I hope you have an idea of what I must do to keep SCRID CMP in compliance with RID PDC standards and criteria.
