#### Motion 20170923.3

#### Rationale:

The SCRID recently got a request about the possibility of sending a representative from the SCRID Board to the CAD conference, scheduled for September 28-30, 2017 in Sacramento, California. As one of the major conferences that focuses on the issues that affect the Deaf Community in the state of California, it is of great interest of sending and having a representative from the Board at the conference. Included in the agenda will be issues of representation of interpreters in the media due to the public nature of

interpreting services and criticism as well as standards of interpreter qualification and licensure in California. Therefore, it is imperative that RID affiliate chapters have a significant presence and provide both input and solidarity regarding these issues at CAD conferences.
