

SCRID Membership Committee Report

January 2019

The Membership Committee reports:

- We have mailed out six (6) new member cards in November-January. All mailed cards/Members have been verified as “Active” and “Paid” in Wild Apricot. With the start of the free Leadership Orientation Series Webinars, we saw a rise in more Student-level and Certified-/Associate-Memberships.
- We have assisted three (3) members with Membership issues in November-January.
- The FREE SCRID Leadership Orientation online webinars scheduled for November 2018 through January 2019: [Introduction to SCRID and the SCRID Website](#) (11/13/18), [SCRID Bylaws Review](#) (11/27/18), [Policies & Procedures I \(Position Descriptions\)](#) (12/04/18), [Policies & Procedures II \(Meeting Standing Rules\)](#) (12/18/18), and [Policies & Procedures III \(Misc Policies\)](#) (01/08/19). *Webinars were recorded and archived as a member perk.*
- The Membership Committee, in concert with the Executive Board (President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer) and the Members-At-Large (Deaf, IDP, Diversity) is in the process of meeting to brainstorm and develop criteria for Interpreter Referral Agency Organizational Members. We have noticed the increased number of ASL-English (only) Interpreter Referral Agencies and more Spoken-Language Interpreter Referral Agencies (wanting to provide ASL-English Interpreting Services) who want to join SCRID. Unfortunately, some may not be Deaf Community-centric. Worse, some agencies lack ethical business practices: disregarding RID/SCRID Mission Statements, Best Practices in Interpreting, and the RID-NAD CPC. This undermines the integrity of the interpreting field in Southern California and nationwide, potentially harming Deaf consumers with inadequate interpreting services or unethical practices by unqualified interpreters. Standardizing expectation criteria for these potential Organizational Members will help to bolster the integrity of the Interpreting Profession, upholding Mission Statements, and ethical best practices.
- We regularly audit the Wild Apricot Database in order to ensure that all Members’ Profile Information has been input correctly and completely. There are still multiple profiles missing “Proof of Certification”, RID Member #s, current/updated Student Transcripts/Enrollment Schedules, etc. This is a reminder that a complete Member Profile allows you to be informed of essential SCRID communications and updates in a timely manner, but also allows you to easily search and be found as you expand your professional and personal networks with like-minded individuals. Correct and Valid RID Member #s allow your vote to be counted!
- The Membership Committee and RID’s Membership Services continue to work closely to audit our current membership, reconciling appropriately matching Membership Categories, Contact Information, and correctly identified Certification titles.
